Dedicated

I have an affinity for big trucks of all kinds. My daddy was a truck driver most of his life, picking up “canned milk” in the 1950’s to delivering feed to farmers in the 1960’s and 1970’s, then back to picking up milk in a tandem tank truck in the late 1970’s. As a little boy, I was allowed to ride with him as we visited dairy farms, and I loved it! As an adult, I am working towards achieving credentials so I can drive commercially soon. Thanks to my dad, I have a connection to the transport business. Hence, while driving, I will see a commercial truck hard at work and on the door I will occasionally see this word: *Dedicated*. This generally means the owner of the truck is only working for one particular business or vendor. Meaning, they are not for hire. This word on the door makes it clear that truck is not available. However, having “dedicated” on the door sends the message, “I have a job to do and I will not be distracted from it.”
