When is Jesus Coming Back?

Jesus is coming again! It could be tonight. It could be tomorrow. Many Bible passages tell us that Christ's return is imminent; that it could happen at any moment.

In fact, John tells us that this is not only the last days ... but the last hour (1 John 2:18).

And, yet nearly 2,000 years have come and gone, and we are still waiting for Jesus to return. Why is this? Does that mean that somehow Jesus goofed when he promised that he would come back, soon?

Jesus was not mistaken. He understood the nature of God. The Bible tells us: "... do not forget this one thing, dear friends: With the Lord a day is like a thousand years, and a thousand years are like a day" (2 Peter 3:8). It might have been 2000 years for us, but for the Lord it's just been two days.

Now, the thing is, no one knows when Jesus will come back again. In fact, Jesus himself said: "No one knows about that day or hour, not even the angels in heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father" (Matthew 24:36; Mark 13:32).

No one knows when Christ will return. No angel, no prophet, no so called "Bible Decoder," or no numerologist, Not even Jesus, himself knows when this will occur. In fact, there have been many who claimed that they knew when he was coming. But each time they have been proven as false prophets.
