Make some cookies (or cookies and ice cream) and take it to someone as a “just because” gift of love. Joshua 24:15 speaks to serving the Lord as opposed to serving the idols of the Amorites in the Promised Land. What does that service look like practically? Would service to others be involved? Jesus would talk about service and love to others in Matthew 25:31-46 and connect the two realities that godly, sacrificial service to others is service to God.

Ask others for prayers. That is, ask others if you can pray for them. When you are at a restaurant and about to say a prayer for the meal, ask your waiter or waitress if you could pray for them about something. At those family reunions and camps, ask others what and who you can pray for. Consider friends from school this summer and ask what kinds of prayers they need. James 5:16-18 teaches that prayer works. Paul charges us to “pray without ceasing” (1 Thes. 5:17) and to “give thanks always and for everything and in all circumstances” (Eph. 5:20; 1 Thes. 5:18).

Be intentional this summer! It is coming quickly. Keep God in all your plans and think of practical ways to serve and encourage others. You may even begin to develop habits you take into the fall and beyond!
