Once there was a little fly who saw a spider's web in the corner of the room. In the same room was a little girl who had broken a vase. Something whispered in her ear, "Hide the pieces and don't tell mother." "No, no!" she said. "If I should deceive mother once, I might again, and pretty soon I should be telling lies. I won't begin." Wasn't she a wise little girl?
