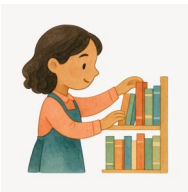

Lessons from a Snowflake

During the huge winter storm that swept across the nation, one weatherman showed an up-close picture of snowflakes , and that reminded me of the amazing beauty of God’s creative power. There are many lessons we can learn from the humble snowflake.

Snowflakes show God’s amazing design. If you look at a snowflake under magnification, you will see they all have six points or sides, but take on an endless variety of shapes, styles, and sizes. What seems simple to the casual observer is actually an individual work of art by the hand of God. *“The heavens declare the glory of God; And the firmament shows His handiwork”* (Psalm 19:1).

Each snowflake is unique. Millions of snowflakes fall on this earth, and each one is different! Many may look similar, but they each have unique qualities that make them special.
