Be thankful for the alarm that goes off in the early morning hours...it means that you're alive.

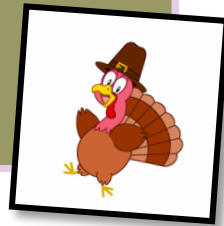
Be thankful for weariness and aching muscles at the end of the day...it means you have been productive.
