






With the joy of this season also come religious Christmas plays, manger scenes, special services in Churches, and all the oft-used expressions such as, "Jesus is the reason for the season, and "Let's put Christ back in Christmas."

The idea behind all these things is that Jesus was born December 25, and therefore we should celebrate that day as the birthday of Jesus. Despite this claim, however, the Bible is silent as to the date Christ was born. Throughout history, men have suggested other dates as the birthday of Christ. The reason for this confusion is that no one knows the date Christ was born. This we do know: the celebration of Christmas is traceable to Liberius, Bishop of Rome, who in A.D. 357 designated December 25 as the day to celebrate Christ's birth. The celebration of Christmas, then, originated with men, not with God.


Yet, in the New Testament there is a day ordained of God when His people are to come together to celebrate. The day is referred to in Scripture as "the Lord's day" (Revelation 1:10). It is the "first day of the week," the day Jesus arose from the dead (Luke 24:1-3). It was upon this day that the early Christians assembled for worship. They remembered the death of Christ as they observed the Lord's Supper (Acts 20:7). They gave of their means (1 Corinthians 16:1-2), prayed (Acts 2:42), sang praises to God (Ephesians 5:19), and studied God's Word (Acts 20:7; Colossians 4:16). This is the special day

Christians are to celebrate.
